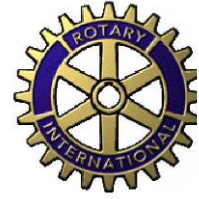

- working out, designing and printing a textbook - a manual "Fostering Cooperation between Schools and Economy – Good Practice Examples from Bosnian-Herzegovinian schools" containing examples of good practice and practical advice for schools in establishing and preserving co-operations with economy, to foster cooperation between vocational secondary colleges, in particular tourism schools, and companies in order to enhance labor market relevance of the vocational school education and increase the employability of school graduates according to the national strategies for the development of education in Bosnia-Herzegovina and the European standards in vocational education
- distributing the manual to partner-schools, other vocational colleges all over BiH, 9 Pedagogical Institutes, Agency for Preschool, Primary and Secondary Education, 13 Ministries for Education and entrepreneurs.
